m amazed," Babcock said learning of the selection on day. "I had no idea my nomon would go this far." The award, the highest available to Army fliers, is presented annually by Quad A, an aviation organization similar to the Association of the U.S. Army.

According to Maj. Henry S. Morgan, Babcock's company commander, each aviation unit on Fort Wainwright forwarded nominations to the commander of the Aviation Brigade. From there, Babcock's nomination was forwarded to division level and then up the chain to Quad A.

Morgan said Babcock was nominated for his work on the HART, which he has commanded since July 1987. "He took a program already in place and continued to improve it," Morgan said.

Babcock's nomination form cited his role in separate rescue missions on Mt. McKinley in May and June 1988. "On both rescue missions, severe winds and white-out conditions from blowing snow made flying particularly hazardous, forcing Mr. Babcock to make

several attempts before he was successful. Pilots with less skill, confidence and dedication would have aborted the mission after the first futile attempts."

Morgan said the rescue missions in May and June 1988 were probably the two highest helicopter hoist rescues ever made.

"I think it's great," said Col. Dean M. Owen, Aviation Brigade commander. "He's a very, very professional aviator... he really deserves the award."
